- Works with Intervention Specialists for prescribed learning necessary for students that have an IEP in place (tracking, providing services, reporting, attending meetings, etc.).
- Works with building leadership for prescribed learning necessary for students that have a 504 plan (tracking, providing services, reporting, attending meetings, etc.).
- Maintains professional and ethical standards in all interactions and communications with students, parents, colleagues, and the community.
